



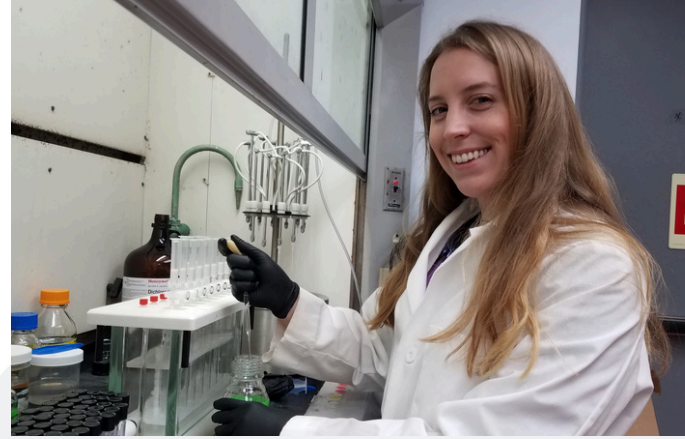
SUPPORT EDUCATION

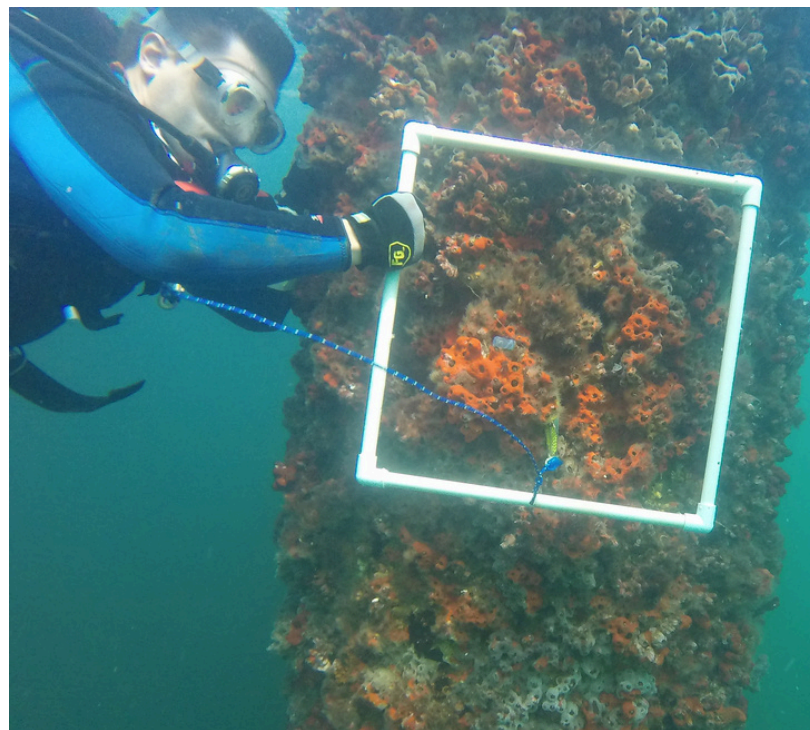

The BayMobile brings the ocean to all ages across the state of Alabama, especially to schools and communities without the opportunity or the means to visit the Dauphin Island Sea Lab on a field trip. Discovery Hall Programs' educators lead audiences on a journey through the northern Gulf of Mexico. The BayMobile gives people the chance to touch the arms of an octopus, see the teeth of a shark, and feel the scales of native fish species.

In 2018, the BayMobile visited 31 schools in 8 Alabama counties during the school year. DHP marine educators connected with more than 7,400 students. The BayMobile programs are free to Title 1 schools in the state of Alabama thanks to the help of our generous donors.
